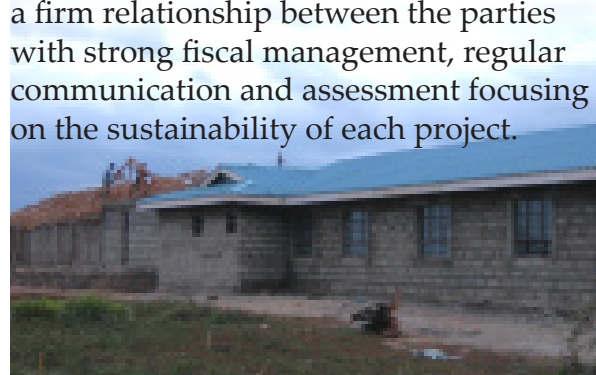

Los Ranchos & Limuru Presbytery Partnership

These two presbyteries have been in partnership for 14 years serving the Lord in ministry together. Our relationship started by building water wells together. The Dick Grace Scholarship Fund provides student tuition and supplies. In 2007, Hoag Memorial Hospital in Los Ranchos joined the partnership in a serious way. The Los Ranchos mission team helped dedicate an orphanage for girls and our medical team equipped 5 dispensaries and trained their healthcare professionals. The partners exchange visits frequently, often several times a year, and follow the progress of our goals weekly.

The partners have a goal to care for each orphan in the Limuru Presbytery by providing financial assistance to adopting families or through two orphanages. Another goal is to provide quality local health care throughout Limuru Presbytery and in particular to these destitute children, widows and Masai girls. This Partnership is founded on a firm relationship between the parties with strong fiscal management, regular communication and assessment focusing on the sustainability of each project.

Every person needs food, clothes, shelter, and love. You can help to provide these essential elements for a child, family or widow today.

Every day 6,000 children lose a parent to AIDS. Every day poverty

kills some of these children. The people of Kenya are generous and willing to care for these destitute children, but they are often financially unable to help. Many families cannot provide food and essentials for their own children, so feeding an additional child is impossible without assistance.



For only \$20 per month, you can provide additional food for the family, uniforms for the child to attend school, blankets or other requirements for daily living. **100% of your donation** goes to the family in the form of essential items.



The Limuru Presbytery Women's Guild will purchase the items and provide them to the family during monthly home visits.



Your donation can change the life of a young Maasai girl. In order to be considered marriageable at age 12, an 11 year old girl would undergo a procedure called female genital mutilation (FGM). This tribal ritual is not performed by medical personnel, so many girls become ill or die from infection. The mutilation also causes an increased rate of death during childbirth from hemorrhage. Your donation will keep a young girl in school and prevent the FGM procedure from being performed until she can decide for herself.



Grace a 72 year old grandmother came to one of the clinics held during the 2007 mission trip to Kenya. She had end stage diabetes. She had no family to care for her, so had not eaten for two days. The Women's Guild is now providing food and medications for her. We

met other widows who are raising their grandchildren, because the widow's children have died of AIDS. Your donation can help provide necessary food and care for destitute widows.

Twice a year, you will receive an update on the status of your child, family or widow. The Women's Guild member who visited the child, family or widow during the year will write the report.

When our mission teams visit our partners in Kenya, they will be able to witness the progress of some of these children, families and widows.
